Dear Sir;

We wish to bring to your attention the activities of a group of un-American persons here in Galloway Township. They are receiving Federal Aid in numerous ways while at the same time engaged in Fifth-columnists activities. All of them are strongly pro-Nazi, anti-Roosevelt, and planning sabotage on Government work when the chance comes.

The group consists of 3 elderly women, (receiving Old Age Aid, and their nephew and niece; living in the 2600 Block White Horse Pike, Galloway Township.

The young man, age 29, is above the present draft age, and skilled at carpentering, sheet-metal work, and welding, - yet will not work because the aged aunts support him. He has just drawn unemployment compensation and finished a course in welding at the Federal School in Atlantic City, -but says he will not work on any Defense Work, except only long enough to sabotage as much as possible in a few weeks and then get out. [redacted] is the name.

The niece, a Mrs. Rider, is busy in Pro-Nazi, anti-Government activity. While taking advantage of the free Government Course in Atlantic City she is engaged in this un-American Propaganda.

They are all clever talkers and will give any investigator plenty of arguments. Insanely pro-Nazi, (not communist.) The County Welfare Director and the A.C. Postmaster has been notified but apparently nothing has been done because their activities continue.

Some of our local Democratic members are aware of this group's un-American leanings, but do not realize the extent of their Fifth columnist activities.

Everywhere they go they spread hatred against the Government, stirring up dissention among the people which is disheartening to those of us who believe in the Democratic principles of the U.S.

Besides, this group does not even pay taxes, and yet absorbs like sponges and gives out only insult to the President and our American way of life.
