

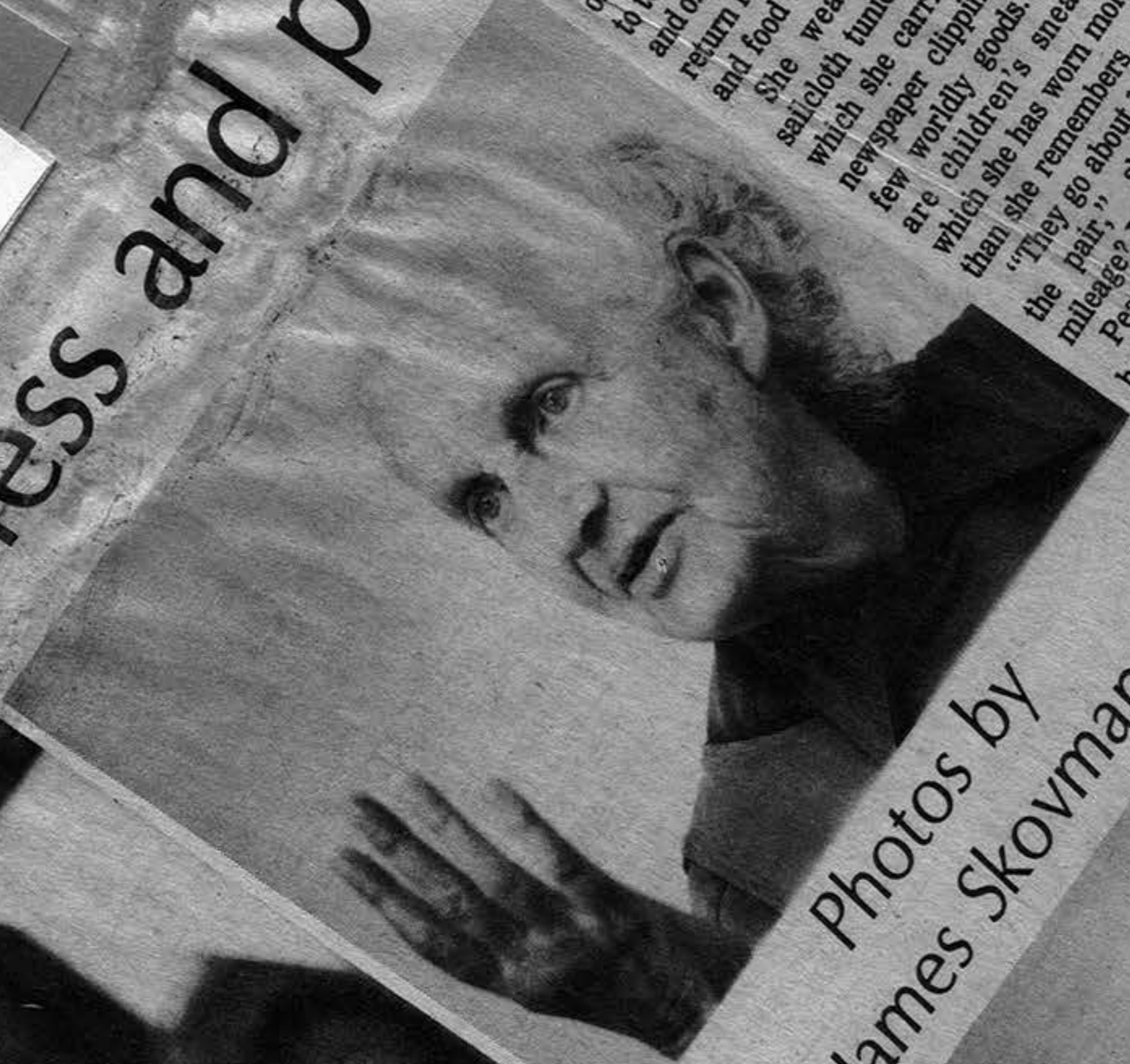
Ageless, nameless and peripatetic, she talks...
